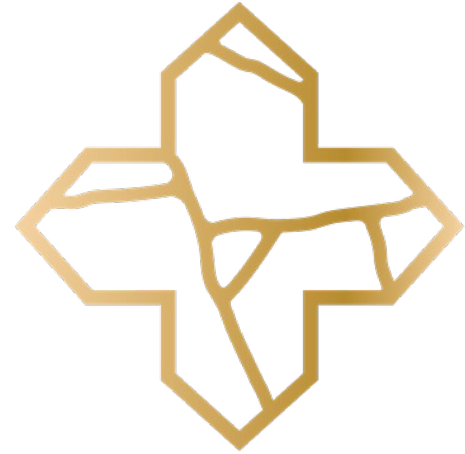

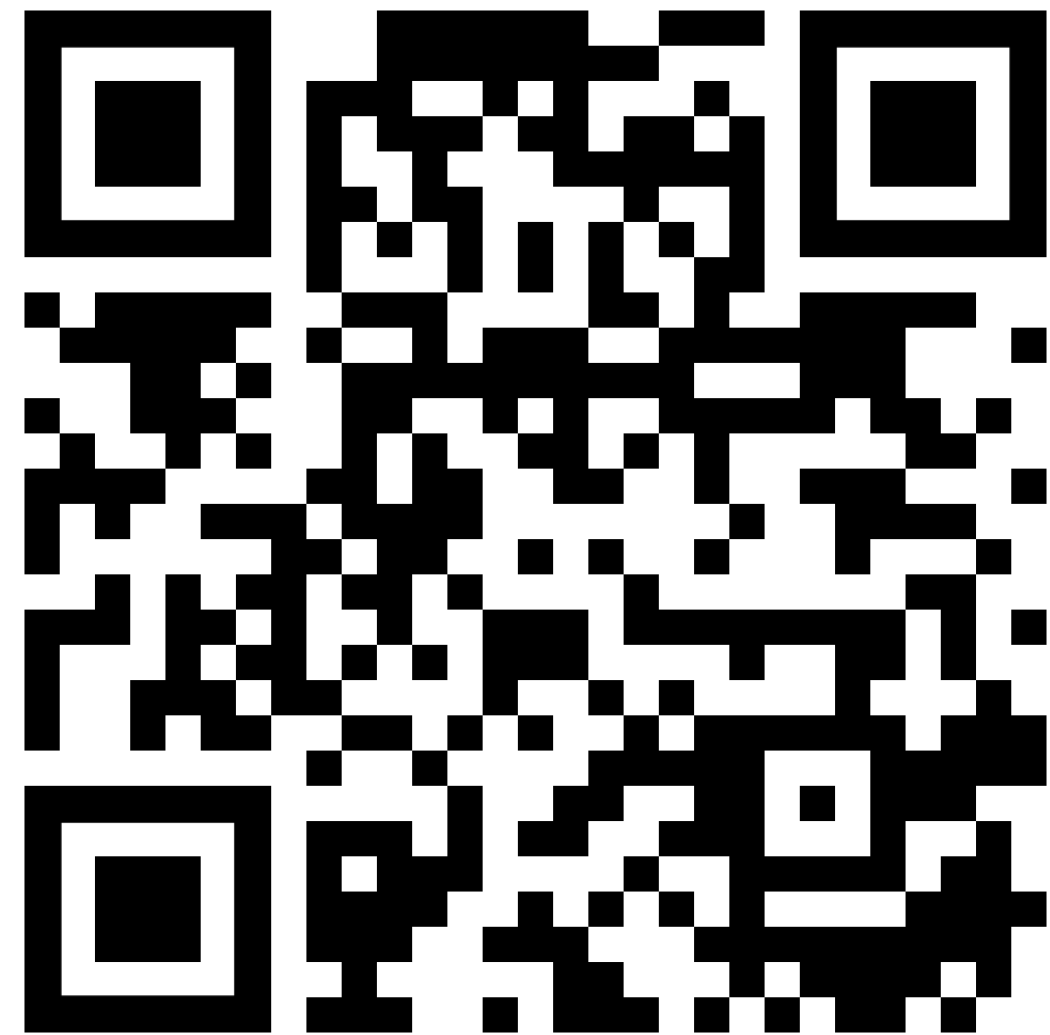

and he must win the battle.



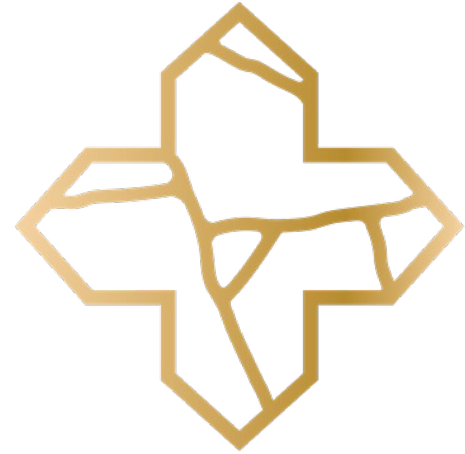
And though this world, with devils filled,

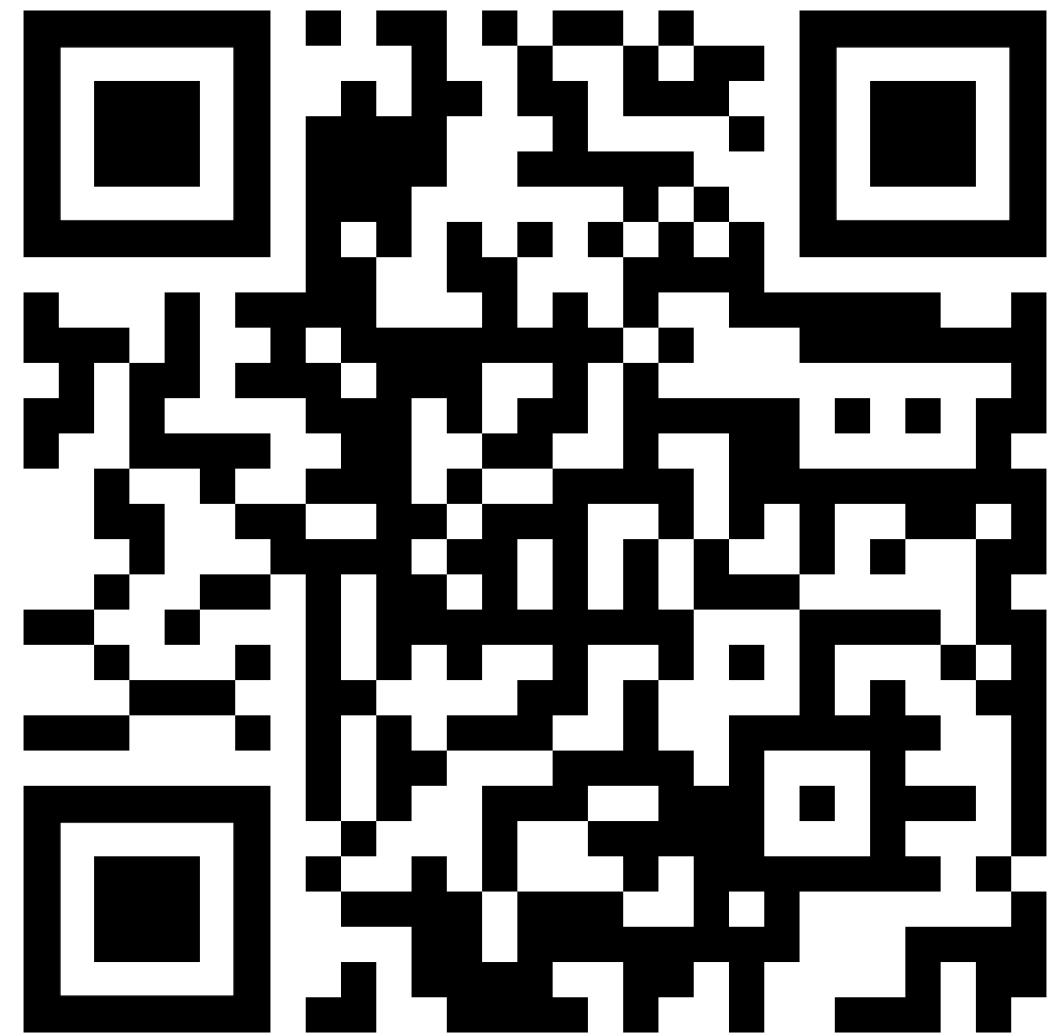
